**The Quest 2020** is an outdoor adventure with hiking and white-water rafting trip for high school and college age men to the Black Hills of South Dakota at the Estes Park YMCA camp sponsored by the Office of Vocations for the Diocese of Sioux City May 30<sup>th</sup>-June 2<sup>nd</sup>. This trip is not focused specifically on vocational discernment; but does include faith-based discussions that will challenge the participants to grow in masculine holiness and provides opportunity for Masses, Adoration, Confession, quality fraternity, and fun activities with other young Catholic men to encourage them to remain faithful during their teenage and young adult years.
