Liturgy Matters: Regarding Holy Communion, (1) NO blessings may be given at Holy Communion. That is the minister of Holy Communion may not touch or speak a blessing to anyone unable to receive Holy Communion; but may say "Receive the Lord in your Heart." Those unable to receive Holy Communion (non-Catholics, Catholics not in good standing), ought to remain in the pew in prayer. Only the presiding priest offers a blessing for everyone gathered at the end of Mass. (2) There is a

one (1) hour fast before Holy Communion. Only water and medicine may be taken within the hour before Holy Communion and those drinking coffee or chewing gum an hour before Holy Communion may not receive Holy Communion. And (3) self-intinction (communicant dipping the host into the chalice) is not permitted.

Used Palm Branches may be brought to church and placed the box marked “Palms.” These will be burned for ashes to be used Ash Wednesday.

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be celebrated during weekend Masses of February 15-16. Persons with chronic health issues/illnesses are asked to sit in the front pews or along the ends of the pews in the center aisle (one or two persons) so they can be conveniently available to be anointed.

The Quest 2020 is an outdoor adventure with hiking and white-water rafting trip for high school and college age men to the Black Hills of South Dakota at the Estes Park YMCA camp sponsored by the Office of Vocations for the Diocese of Sioux City May 30th-June 2nd. This trip is not focused specifically on vocational discernment; but does include faith-based discussions that will challenge the participants to grow in masculine holiness and provides opportunity for Masses, Adoration, Confession, quality fraternity, and fun activities with other young Catholic men to encourage them to remain faithful during their teenage and young adult years. Anyone who is considering the priesthood will be invited to a follow-up event at the August 7-9th Quo Vadis discernment camp in Okoboji. Service Trip to Honduras: You are invited to participate in the Sister Water Project to Honduras July 15th-20th where service team members will help make clean water accessible to the people in the rural village of Mejojote, Honduras. Members must be 18 (16 if accompanied by a parent/guardian) and physically healthy and strong enough to do strenuous activity at higher altitudes. Fees for the trip are \$1,100, which includes ground/air travel, food, and lodging. Applications are due by April 10th.
