OF INTEREST TO BOTH PARISHES

The following events are being restricted until further notice:

1. Baptisms – Baptisms will only be celebrated with immediate family and godparents. There will be no large group baptisms.

3. Funerals – Funerals may be celebrated only with immediate family members. Parishes may not host funeral dinners.
4. Confessions - The Sacrament of Reconciliation (confession) will be conducted by appointment only.

Taking place a decade after the Resurrection, this moving drama follows Mary's last days on earth. Peter visits her, bringing with him the struggles of the Church. Though she is physically separated from Jesus, her reflections on life with Him remind them both that they are always united with Him in their souls.
