Courage is a gift of the Holy Spirit.</p> <p>All parishes across the Diocese of Sioux City continue to remain closed for public Masses.</p> <p>IF we have enough ushers and disinfecting supplies, and there are no increases in COVID-19 cases in our region, we plan to reopen for public weekend Masses on June 27/28 with live streaming of the 5:00 p.m. Saturday Mass. This bulletin reflects this schedule for next weekend. I hope to have ushers ready and trained by this Friday evening, June 26th. Yet, please check the parish website for any change in this schedule if we do not are not able to return to public Mass, in that case we will continue with the schedule as we have done for the last few months, with Sunday Mass online at 9:00 a.m.</p> <p>When we do reopen, parishioners will need to wear face masks and be comfortable to observe social distancing with non-family household members. Thus, our aisles have been marked every six [6] feet and our pews have been ‘roped’ off to make the pews that will be open for use. In addition, ushers will be taking attendance and directing people to pews. We will also attempt to utilize a reservation system to help accommodate people.
