It is a joy to be here in Cherokee and Holstein. I have unpacked most of my bags and I look forward to meeting all of you!!! I am sure most of you know that I was born and raised in Cherokee. I am the youngest of four children. After graduating from high school, I attended and graduated from Iowa State University with a B.S. in Electrical Engineering. I then moved to Vermont to work as a radio frequency engineer.

However, as I moved to Vermont, my childhood call to the priesthood returned. I started to discuss it with my local pastor, and it all started to make sense. After two years of talking, I decided that I should at least try the seminary knowing that I could leave at any point in time. I attended Mt. St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, Maryland for five years. I was ordained for the diocese of Burlington, Vermont on June 6, 1998.

I then served as a priest in Vermont for 15 years and then returned to the Sioux City Diocese. I spent a year in Fort Dodge and then 3 years at Blessed Sacrament. I spent the last 4 years at Mater Dei in Sioux City as the pastor. I love my priesthood and have never regretted answering the call. You are all in my prayers!!!
