### BLACK HISTORY MONTH

*It was noted historian, Dr. Carter G. Woodson in 1915 who visioned a celebration to recognize the glorious and varied achievements of Black Americans. Dr. Woodson along with other scholars founded the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History. The association worked to research and publish findings about black life and history in the Journal of Negro History. Too in 1920, the association sponsored its first Negro History Week. Which was a success. With the the popularity of Negro History Week and the growing Civil Rights Movement, there was a push for an extension of Negro History Week. President Gerald R. Ford in 1976 issued a proclamation formally recognizing Negro History Week as Black History Month. "Black History: A Legacy of Strength. A Future of Hope".*
