Sacred Silence in Mass

"Silence in the liturgy is intended to give expression to the prayers of the people, albeit in the quiet of their hearts, its aim is not to make them passive." The Roman Missal is very direct in what it says about silence in the liturgy; "Sacred Silence also, as part of the celebration, is to be observed at the designated times: At the beginning of the Penitential Act, after the invitation to pray, after each reading, the Homily and after Communion.
