

## **IMPORTANT CARPOOL INFORMATION TEMPORARY CHANGES TO DROP OFF AND PICK UP**

In an effort to increase the safety of our students and families, Christ the King is working with the City of Daphne to explore the possibility of new drop off and pick up procedures for students in grades K-8. A trial run on this proposed plan is scheduled for three days, **Wednesday, February 6 through Friday, February 8**, to evaluate its workability for Christ the King, the City, and the surrounding area.

This trial plan involves making 6<sup>th</sup> Street one way SOUTH to NORTH, open to only CTK families from 7:15 AM until 8:00 AM in the morning for CTKCS student drop off and closing 6<sup>th</sup> Street exclusively for pickup of CTKCS students from 2:15 to 3:15 PM in the afternoon. The pickup and drop off area on Dryer Avenue, behind the Immaculata Center, will remain as it is now. No vehicles will be allowed to park or drive on campus from 7:30 - 8:00 AM and 2:20 PM - 3:20 PM on days that school is in session.

**In the morning**, vehicles will enter 6<sup>th</sup> Street from College Avenue and drop all children off on the passenger side of their car and proceed north to Dryer Avenue, where it is suggested that:

- a. Those with a destination south toward Montrose/Fairhope would take a left on Dryer Ave. then a left on 5<sup>th</sup> St. and proceed south with a route of choice.
- b. Those with a destination north toward Spanish Fort/Mobile would proceed north on 6<sup>th</sup> St., through the Dryer Ave. intersection, and continue with a route of choice. **No right turn from 6<sup>th</sup> St. onto Dryer Ave. is permitted.**

**In the afternoon**, 6<sup>th</sup> Street would become the staging area for school pickup during the street closed hour. Vehicles will enter from College Avenue onto 6<sup>th</sup> St. where all 3 lanes will be utilized for carpool lanes. Parents will exit their cars to pick up their children. No traffic will be allowed to move until the cars in all three lanes are loaded. At that time, the whistle will blow and the first lane will exit followed by the 2<sup>nd</sup>, and then by the last. **NO CHANGING OF LANES WILL BE PERMITTED.** When exiting, traffic would flow as follows:

- a. Those with a destination south toward Montrose/Fairhope would take a left on Dryer then left on 5<sup>th</sup> St. and proceed south with a route of choice.
- b. Those with a destination north toward Spanish Fort/Mobile would proceed north on 6<sup>th</sup> St. through the Dryer Avenue intersection and continue with a route of choice. **No right turn from 6<sup>th</sup> St. onto Dryer Avenue is permitted.**
