

After School Care Feasibility Survey

Dear Parents,

Thank you for your response to the After School Care Feasibility Survey. The information that you provided has allowed us to analyze our current situation and look at the possibility of adding after school care for the second semester. We are doing all we can to make sure that our school is acting responsibly and safely while still providing as many services as we can during this pandemic.

The results suggest that a number of you would indeed be interested in the After School Care program if offered. However, current restrictions dictated by the Office of Catholic Schools requires that all A and B classes remain separated during the school day. This unfortunately would mean that in order to provide after school care, we would be required to hire a minimum of 6 new staff members and place all classes in separate locations, with limited to no outside play time. We feel that this would not be economically or physically possible for us to support. Because of this, we have made the difficult decision that we cannot resume After School Care at this time. We will reassess the situation if and when COVID-related precautions are relaxed.

We appreciate your understanding and hope that we will be resuming these services in due time. We know that this is a hardship for some families and regret that we can't offer this as a solution for our family's after school needs.
