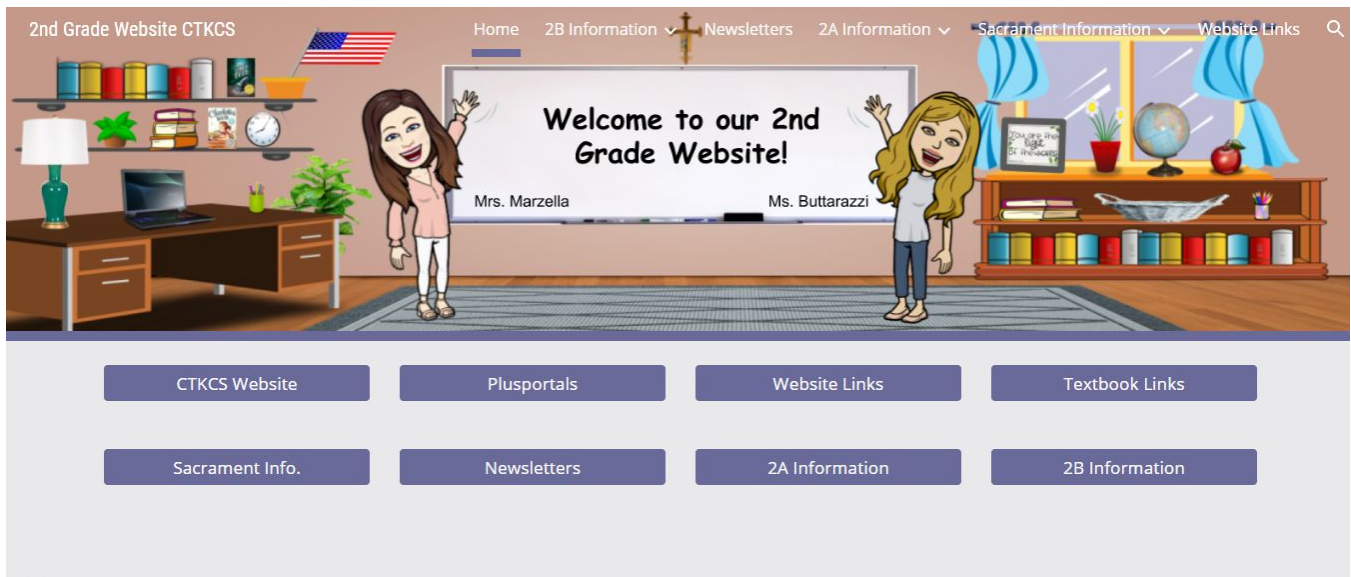


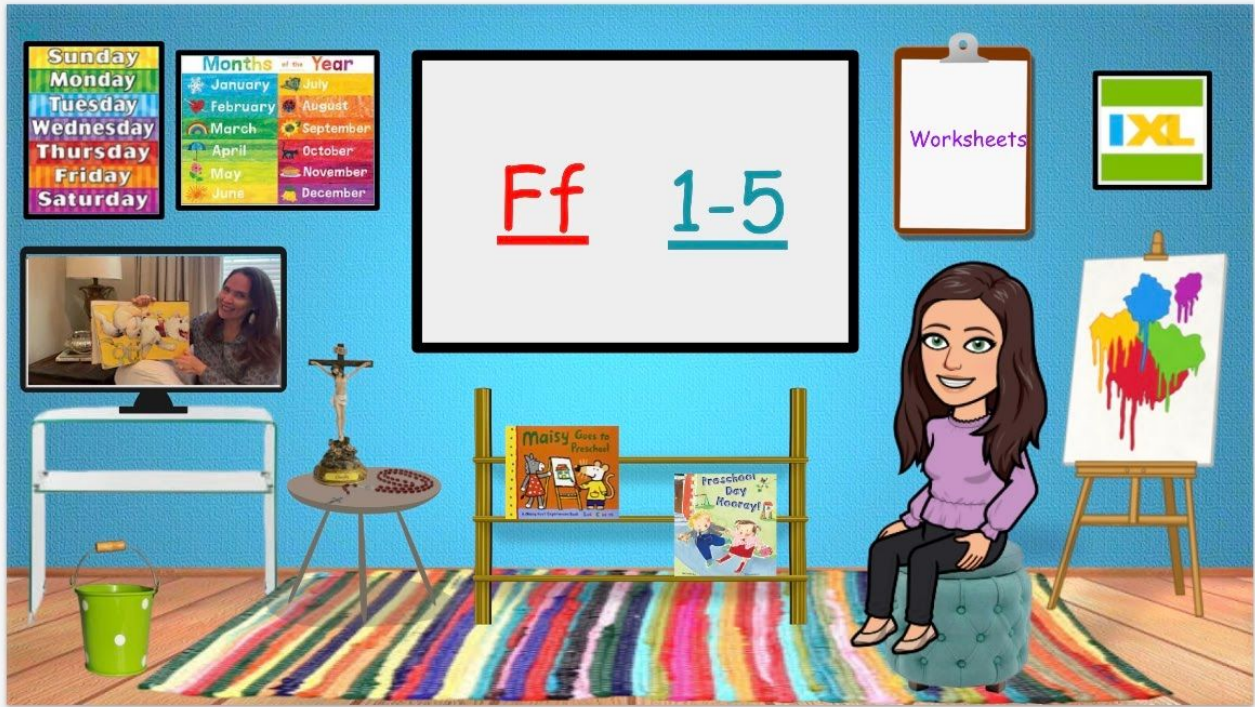
Digital Classrooms
