

NEW TRAFFIC PROCEDURES AS OF 8/13/20

For the safety of our CTKCS families and Faculty, we have reevaluated the arrival and dismissal procedures for K-8, **effective immediately**.
Preschool arrival and dismissal will remain the same.

ARRIVAL - STARTING AT 7:15 AM

For arrival, parents have two options.

Option A: Parents may enter through the Main Street entrance, (the traffic pattern we used last year) with the exit to College Street (right turn only).

Option B: Parents may park at the Immaculata Center, there will be a crossing guard to help students cross safely.

When parents drop their students off, the students will precede to the nearest checkpoints to have their temperature taken. They will receive a green sticker and go to class if their temperature is below 100.4. In the event that a student has a temperature of more than 100.4, the students will be quarantined and parents will be called to come pick them up immediately.

Checkpoints will be located in four areas. 1) will be near the rear gym gate before entering the K-3 Breezeway; 2) will be near the school office, 3) will be between the 5th and 6th grade classrooms; 4) will be near the 8th grade classrooms.


DISMISSAL - STARTING AT 3:00 PM

We will now have two dismissal options after school. **Students MUST know who will pick them up and where they will be picked up.** Students may remove their masks when they are off campus. We will not use the carline family numbers in the future.

Option A: Students may walk to the Immaculata Center parking lot to meet their parents. Students who will walk home will walk to one of two crossing guards to safely cross the street. Mr. Chris Redlich will return to the crossing guard post on Dryer Avenue and Mrs. Bea Hernandez will remain the crossing guard on Main Street.

Option B: Parents may enter the main parking lot though College Avenue as we have in the past. Students who do not walk to the Immaculata Center parking lot will be dismissed to the main parking lot. We will socially distance the students as much as possible while they are waiting for their parents to pick up. We ask that the parents pick up students as quickly as possible without visiting. This will not be an opportunity to conference with a teacher after school. Parents must wear a mask if they get out of their car. We still need our students to be picked up as close to 3:00 as possible.
