Dear Parents,

We are now halfway through the 2nd quarter! This would be a good time to check your child's grades on Plus Portal and to discuss their academic goals with them. It was wonderful to see the kids' faces this week.

COVID Updates

Please continue to screen your child for symptoms of COVID-19 or other illnesses at home. The Christ the King School community had 7 positive COVID cases this week.

If your student has been quarantined, please do not send them to their sports practices or clubs.

After each case is reported, our team does a thorough contact tracing in all of the classrooms. So far, there is nothing that has indicated that our students have transmitted the virus to each other at school.

It is highly recommended that you talk to your pediatrician about the COVID vaccine. Please remember that masks are optional and to let your child's homeroom teacher know if you expect your child to wear a mask during the school day.

The classrooms will be fogged and cleaned with disinfectant this weekend. The faculty and staff at CTK are maintaining our COVID protocols.

Dismissal Changes to begin on November 29th.

In a continuing effort to provide a safe environment for our students and to better utilize our faculty and staff, we find it necessary to change some afternoon pick-up policies. No student will be permitted to leave campus via the courtyard. *All students that leave at 3:00 must be picked up at the sixth street carpool.*

If you would like to park at the Immaculata Center and walk to the Sixth Street pickup, that is permitted. Students may not leave until a teacher gives permission.

This does not affect students who have been approved to walk home.
