Brothers and Sisters,

Last week you heard about our revamped Religious Education program, "A Family of Faith," which we are beginning this week. I would like to follow up with you regarding our Youth program for this coming year. Unfortunately, our search for a Director of Evangelization for Youth and Young Adults for various reasons did not result in a hire. It is true that with the transition of pastors, we entered into the game a bit late.

The youth of our parish are a priority. I have decided, therefore, to make our youth a primary focus of my ministry for this year. I am forming a team of parents and young adults to help me run our outreach to middle and high school youth. If you are interested in helping, please contact me. We will continue to use the LifeTeen and Edge programs, and my hope is that some of our dedicated high school youth will also help evangelize the middle school youth. Because of this situation, we will not be offering a Confirmation program this year, but will the following year.

Please pray for the fruitfulness of this project and stay tuned for our launch, with the hope that we will bring onboard a full-time Director of Evangelization for Youth and Young Adults next spring.

I also wanted to let you know that this past week I named Mrs. Julie Onderko part-time "Coordinator of Evangelization", and formally brought her onto the parish staff. She has earned her Masters in Theology from the Augustine Institute and brings considerable parish experience. She has already been helping with Baptismal Preparation and Adult Confirmation. She will now also coordinate our RCIA program and help launch our youth program. Julie is well known in our parish, and we are delighted to have her serving in this new capacity.
