This Sunday we embark on a series of liturgical feasts: Ascension, Pentecost, Trinity Sunday and Corpus Christi. These are deep mysteries of the Faith and I encourage us to pray and to enter deeply into their celebration, and to take advantage of the opportunities in the parish in addition to the Sacred Liturgy. Details of these events can be found in the bulletin.

After the 5:30 p.m. Vigil Mass for Pentecost, June 8th, we have our **Pentecost Celebration** with a potluck and talent show. I'm greatly looking forward to joining the celebration. Our parish is rich in ethnic diversity, and part of the mystery of Pentecost is how the Holy Spirit unites people of different languages and ethnicity in the one true Faith. It's beautiful how the Faith transcends and unites different nationalities, ethnicities and languages to form a unity of the human race from the fragmentation and division caused by sin. The farther we move away from God, the farther we move away from each other. The Good News is the Father and the Son have sent the Holy Spirit into the world to effect the transformation of the members of Christ's Mystical Body (the Church) to render them Christ-like, uniting them in the intimate union of a body.

After the 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Masses on Sunday, June 9th, we will be **honoring Gus Pappelis** for his many years of service to this parish in leading the music at the various liturgies. We will miss him in this capacity and are so grateful for all he has been and done for this parish these many years. Please come to the parish center after Mass to celebrate with him.

Finally, please consider participating in **Adult Vacation Bible School**, which will run from June 3-7. I know it probably does not have as much singing and running around as Vacation Bible School, but it does promise to be a spiritually fruitful time of learning and fellowship. This year Adult VBS will be viewing and discussing Bishop Barron's videos on the Mass. Please come!
