Brothers and Sisters,

A heartfelt thank you to all those who helped make the funeral of our beloved **Fr. Ted Weber** a beautiful celebration. He will be missed. It was a real privilege to have him concelebrating from his wheelchair at the 10:30 Mass for those months until his condition prevented him from coming. Thank you to those who took turns bringing him to Mass. The first time I met him was as a deacon back in the late 90's. My summer assignment was to go around to parishes in the Archdiocese preaching on vocations. Fr. Weber, then pastor of St. Philip Benizi, was one of the first pastors to call up and schedule a weekend. That's only one small example of his dedication to the priestly ministry.

I also wanted to thank Evelyn Thornton, our multi-cultural committee, and all those who helped make our **Pentecost celebration** so wonderful: the Mass, the fellowship, the food, and the talent show. It was a great time of celebrating our cultural diversity united in the one Faith!

I am happy to report that our parish now has a **stunningly beautiful canopy** for processions with the Blessed Sacrament! Some of you from the morning Mass were able to see it when it arrived and was tested. It was designed and executed by our own Theresa Rivelli. You can see its debut in our Corpus Christi Procession after the 10:30 a.m. Mass on Corpus Christi (June 23). Check the bulletin and the website for details. Bringing back this Eucharistic Procession, which has been going on in the Church for over 1,000 years, is a great way to honor and adore the Lord in His Real Presence and to grow together as a Eucharistic Parish. The canopy is an integral part of processing with the Blessed Sacrament as it provides cover, reminds us of Who it is we are carrying, and to help people who are at a distance see the Blessed Sacrament.

We now have a weekly **e-bulletin** that is emailed every Monday. The first issue was sent out last week. The e-bulletin has a link to Sunday's homily, upcoming events and important announcements, and is a great way to stay up to date with what is going on here at the parish. I had one parishioner express her appreciation for it as she received it while traveling in Europe. It helped her feel connected to the parish.
