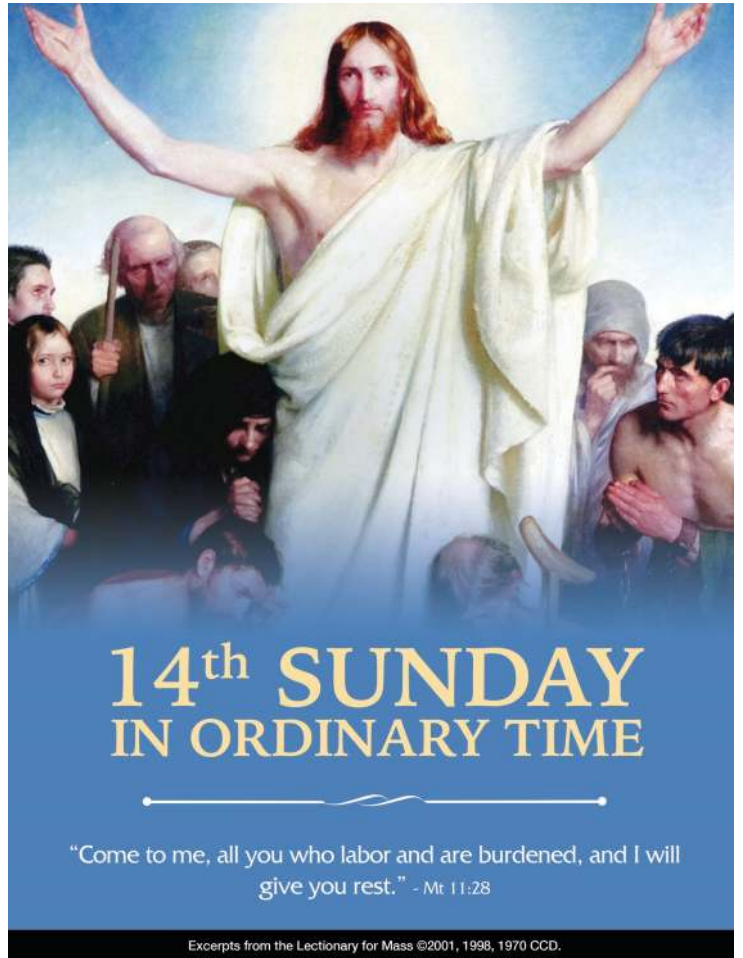

The Sacrament of Holy Baptism

We require that you contact the Church Parish Office before the child is born or shortly after birth and pick up a Holy Baptismal Packet. Once the packet is completed both parents must attend a Baptism Class. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Confirmed Roman Catholic in good standing who regularly attend Sunday Holy Mass.

The Sacrament of Holy Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. To avoid schedule conflicts, all wedding dates held at Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary and St. Frances Cabrini Church must be confirmed with the Pastor, who should be the first contact of the couple. Please pick up a wedding guidelines booklet at the Church Parish Office or online for details of paper work and preparation requirements.

The Rite of Holy Christian Burial

Our Roman Catholic Faith teaches the infinite value of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass for the repose of the soul of a departed one. Roman Catholic Church law states that the Mass of Christian burial is properly celebrated in the Church. (Code of Canon Law: 1177 § 1)

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

July 5, 2020
14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

We are all familiar with the refrain, “You have put on Christ. In him you have been baptized. Alleluia, alleluia!” In Baptism, we “put on” Christ. In putting on Christ, we put on all that Christ is and represents: hope, faith, and love. We are no longer bound to the sins and failures of the flesh, that part of us that resists God and relies exclusively on human means. It also means that we are not in debt to our past, complete with its sins, failures, regrets, fears, and unfulfilled dreams. There is always hope. In putting on Christ, we put on God’s vision for the world, for all of His children and for us. We have been given a road map to guide our paths and a blueprint to follow for our life’s journey.

There is no need for regret, and we are not tethered to our past. Is there anything in your past that you regret? Any decision or memory that continues to haunt you? We have all made mistakes, and we have this uncanny ability to continue beating ourselves up over things we can no longer do anything about, except learn from them. To put on Christ means that I can now bring God’s unconditional love to my hurtful memories and sinful choices. With each new moment and every new choice, I can start clean and live in freedom.

Imagine adults when the disciples were preaching and baptizing. They came to baptism not really knowing who they were, with pasts that were broken, seeking to live the joy of the Gospel they heard spoken to them and wanting the love they saw witnessed in the lives of those who believed. What tremendous celebrations their baptisms must have been! They could now have the support of a community, full participation in the sacraments of the church, focus for their disordered lives, consolation, healing, and an understanding of what life is really all about.

Our lives are meant to be celebrations of the Spirit we have received in Baptism. How does that joy get expressed in and through you? When we truly understand that we have put on Christ, our burdens can become much lighter. It is odd that so many Christians look like they are carrying the weight of the world on their shoulders. Wouldn’t it be wonderful if those weights could be lifted and joy experienced!

Prayer Blanket Ministry

The prayer blanket is a crocheted lap-ghan. Prayers are said with every stitch. The colors usually represent the illness. It measures 40" x 52" with an insert of a cross. Example: For bone cancer—the cross would be yellow with a purple background. After the blanket is completed is it folded, wrapped with a ribbon and accompanied by a prayer card. Then brought to be blessed by Fr. Mark. The blanket is usually requested by a friend or family member. It is not sold but a donation to help pay for supplies is appreciated. Once the recipient receives the blanket "PLEASE" unwrap it and use it. My name is Ruby Duhon and I make prayer blankets. My phone number is (337) 652-1337 if you would like to place an order.

How to Use Text Giving

- Text the word GIVE to 13374677797
- If it's your first time, you'll be prompted to click a link directing you to the online giving page to complete a one-time registration. Click "SIGN IN" then click "REGISTER FOR AN ACCOUNT" at the bottom of the page.
- Complete contact information then click "REGISTER."
- Enter the secure PIN that the system texts you.
- Select the fund, enter the donation amount and payment information before completing your gift.
- Click "SAVE PAYMENT" to keep your payment information securely saved for future gifts.
- To text a donation after the one-time registration, you can give immediately without having to re-enter any of your information.
- Simply text the desired amount and the fund keyword to the text giving number. Ex: 250 tithe for \$250.00 to the Tithe fund.

Other Text Commands

EDIT – Make changes to your giving account and update contact information and/or update payment information.
REFUND – Refund your last gift. You must text "REFUND" within 15 minutes to refund the gift. If you realized the mistake after 15 minutes, contact the church or organization you are giving to for a refund.
KEYWORD – See a list of active keywords. Keywords are the fund names that the church has set up.
