

Baptism Policies and Forms

Congratulations on the birth of your child! Now that you have brought your child into the world, it's time to bring him or her into the family of God to begin a journey of faith life that is filled with God's grace and blessings.

The first of all Sacraments, baptism calls us into the family of God as His adopted sons and daughters, imparting upon those who are baptized, the grace of being cleansed from original sin. In dying and rising to new life that is the drama of Baptism, the individual is freed from the bonds of sin and death and given the promise of new life. To have your child baptized at Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary Catholic Church, please read the Baptism policy.

If you have not attended a baptism class in the past 5 years you need to attend a class. Both parents and both Godparents if possible must attend. Please contact the office to set a date and time for class.

Infants are to be baptized according to the norms of the Rite of Baptism. Children of Catechetical age and adults are to be initiated according to the principles of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (see RCIA). The primary responsibility of raising a child in the faith rests with the parents. The parish is to provide preparation for the parents.

PARISH REQUIREMENTS: Anyone who is a parishioner living within the geographical boundaries of the parish, or is a registered member on the parish census, is eligible to have their child/children baptized at Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary/St. Frances Cabrini. Any discussion regarding baptisms will only be had with the biological parents (Adoptive parents included). Grandparents, friends, aunts, uncles, legal guardians, someone speaking on the parent's behalf, cannot schedule baptisms, or to provide the staff with any personal information regarding the child or parents. If this is the first child for either the mother or the father, both parents must attend a Baptism preparation course by Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary/St. Frances Cabrini prior to scheduling a baptism. Again if there is a problem with any parent attending the classes please contact the office 337-643-6472.

SCHEDULING BAPTISMS: There will not be more than (2) baptisms scheduled at a time. All parties (parents, godparents, grandparents, family etc.) are expected and required to attend the liturgy (Mass) immediately before the baptism is celebrated. If the parents or godparents are late, or do not show up, the baptism will be rescheduled for another date. **ALL FORMS MUST BE FILLED OUT AND APPROVED BEFORE A BAPTISM IS SCHEDULED.**

SINGLE PARENTS/UNWED PARENTS: The consent of both biological (not legal guardians) parents must be obtained prior to the celebration of Baptism. In case of single parents, a written statement of consent to have the child baptized from the non-custodial parent must be provided to the pastor prior to scheduling a meeting with a pastor, or scheduling the Baptism, unless the parental rights have been legally relinquished by the non-custodial parent (proof must be provided). In the event that a couple is not married, a copy of the child's original birth certificate must be obtained in order to state the biological father in the baptismal records.

BAPTISM POLICIES

Selection of God Parents:

Selecting a godparent for a child is a delicate and serious task. Not every adult who will be in a child's life, not every family friend, not every aunt or uncle or cousin will be suitable for the role of godparents.

For good and salutary reasons, the Church lays down requirements for being a godparent. To be a godparent, one must be baptized and confirmed Catholic who regularly practices the faith and can receive sacraments of the Church, especially the Holy Eucharist. In order to be admitted as a godparent, one must "have the aptitude and intention of fulfilling this function."

The reason for these requirements is that the godparent must be able to give a coherent witness of the Christian life of his godchild. Strengthened by the sacraments of salvation and living the life of grace, the godparent "helps the baptized person to lead a Christian life....and to fulfill faithfully the obligations inherent on it."

From this, certain people are UNABLE to be godparents:

- 1) Those who are not BAPTIZED and CONFIRMED;
- 2) Those who are not Catholic;
- 3) Those who are not regularly practice their faith by (at minimum) attending Mass on Sundays and going to confession from time to time;
- 4) Those who cannot receive Holy Communion because of an irregular marriage situation.

The Church sets the requirements for being a godparent (and a confirmation sponsor) not in order to exclude certain people, but because the role of godparent is uniquely important and carries with it responsibilities that demand an authentic witness of Christian faith.

That said, parents and grandparents must take great care in selecting godparents and must ensure that they meet these requirements. It is always prudent to check with the pastor of Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary/Cabrini Parish before asking someone to serve as godparent, so as to avoid any hard feelings or awkward situations.

No one has a right to be a godparent, especially one who does not meet the requirements set forth by the Church. What's more, every child deserves an authentic godparent, one who can be a guide in the ways of faith and who can give genuine and faithful witness to the life of grace.

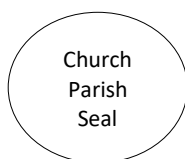
