The First reading (2 Maccasbees 7:1-29-14) and the Gospel (Luke 20:27-38) of this Sunday address some of the questions and concerns contemporary Christians have about resurrection.

What is *life after death* is impossible to explain. But, I've found it helpful to my understanding by listening to the greater Easter Hymn "I know that my Redeemer lives!" by Samuel Medley (STM Worship #527). The Song begins and ends with this proclamation:

I know that my Redeemer lives!
What joy this assurance gives!
He lives, he lives, who once was dead;
He lives, my ever-lasting head!

George Frideric Handel in 1741 composed a glorious soprano solo on these words. (You can find one rendition of the Messiah in the internet.) It is the piece in "Messiah" that follows the "Hallelujah" chorus, proclaiming reason, hope and joy in the face of Sadness. For millennia, through prayer and preaching and beautiful music, the Church has proclaimed that Redeemer to be Jesus the Christ. It is a word of hope in the face of despair, a word of life on the face of death.

In this month of November, let us continue to remember and pray for those who died before us in faith. May all the faithful departed rest in peace and rise in glory with Christ our Savior.

La primera lectura 2 de Macabeos 7: 1-29-14 y del Evangelio de San Lucas 20: 27-38 de este domingo se dirige a algunas de las preguntas y preocupaciones de los cristianos contemporáneos acerca de la resurrección.

Que es *la vida despues de la muerte* es imposible de explicar. Sin embargo, he encontrado que es muy útil para mi al escuchar el Himno mayor de Pascua para entenderlo "Yo sé que mi Redentor vive!", De Samuel Medley que se encuentra en el Libro Roja de Cantos en Ingles # 527). La canción comienza y termina con esta proclamacion:

Yo sé que mi Redentor vive!
Qué alegría da esta seguridad!
Vive, vive, que una vez estaba muerto;
Vive, eternamente en mi mente!

El Sr. Georg Friedrich Handel en 1741 compuso un oratorio glorioso de las estrofas mencionadas.(Que puedes encontrar una versión de El Mesías en la internet.) En la parte donde dice "Mesías" luego sigue el "Aleluya" del coro, que proclama la razón, la esperanza y la alegría en la cara de la tristeza. Durante miles de años, a través de la oración y la predicación y la música hermosa, la Iglesia ha proclamado que el Redentor es Jesús el Cristo. Es una palabra de esperanza en una cara de desesperación, una palabra de vida en la cara de la muerte.

En este mes de Noviembre, vamos a seguir recordando y orando por los que murieron antes que nosotros en la fe. Que todos los fieles difuntos descansen en paz y que aciendan en la gloria con Cristo nuestro Salvador.
