So, will I see you at the meeting? I have a few extras of his book, if you desire to obtain it from me?

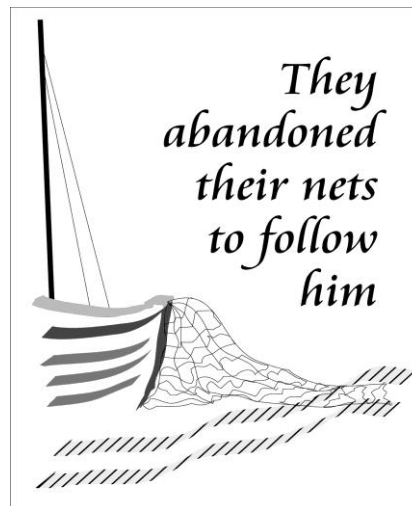
