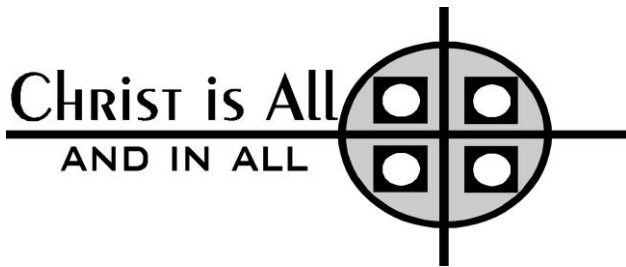

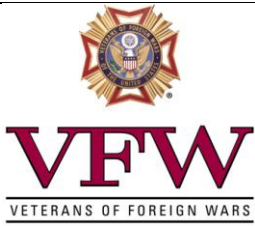

All payments and registration forms must be submitted to the rectory.

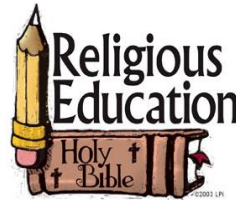
SUMMER ATTIRE

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION UPDATE



Registration forms for the 2016/2017 Religious Education Program year were mailed out the beginning of June to families already in our system. Please read all the information contained in your packet that some of the information has changed i.e. class options and fees.

Registrations are due before July 31st. If you are waiting to register due to the fall activities / schedules we ask that you send in the form and we can work out the day/time options in August. **IMPORTANT – Forms received and postmarked after July 31st will be put on hold and the family will be required to pay a \$25 late fee.** If your family is experiencing financial hardship please contact the Mrs. McGuire, DRE to discuss your circumstances. The late fee does not apply to new families to the program.
