In the Book of Genesis we read: God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it he rested from all the work he had done in creation (Gn 2:3). Besides a Sabbath rest every seven days, there was also one every seven years. In the Book of Leviticus we read: For six years you may sow your field, and for six years prune your vineyard, gathering in their produce. But during the seventh year the land shall have a sabbath of complete rest, a Sabbath for the Lord, when you may neither sow your field nor prune your vineyard (Lev 25:3-4). Based on the biblical injunction of the Sabbath rest, the concept of sabbatical has evolved in modern times as a period of rest, rejuvenation, and study. Our Diocese has a policy that priests are eligible for a sabbatical after each seven years of service in the Diocese: "A sabbatical leave is an approved leave, normally three months in length, without the loss of assignment; its purpose is one of the renewal, enrichment, and personal growth." I will be away from our Parish from **April 15, 2018 till August 1, 2018**. Please pray for me safe travels. Fr Jarek.
