Bishop Edward Rice invites you to participate as he leads the annual Corpus Christi Procession on **Sunday, June 23rd**, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, at 1 p.m., from the Cathedral of St. Mary of the Annunciation in Cape Girardeau. Join Catholics from across the diocese to publicly express belief in Jesus Christ, truly present in the Blessed Sacrament, through prayer, song, and reflection on the Mystery of the Most Holy Eucharist along the procession's half-mile route. The Celebration will end with Benediction at Old St. Vincent Chapel of Ease. Children who have recently received their First Holy Communion are invited to participate in their First Communion attire. All priests and deacons are invited to vest and join in the procession.
