(South Africa, Malawi, Batswana, Cameroon, Liberia, Chad, Central African Republic, The Gambia, Nigeria, Kenya, and Southern Sudan) They are also in Grenada in the West Indies, the United States, England, Sweden, and Ireland and have about 134 seminarians in their seminary in Nigeria.
