Notes on Ash Wednesday - Distribution of Ashes in a Time of Pandemic

While Ash Wednesday is not a hold day of obligation, it is rightly observed as a celebration of high importance/ During this time of pandemic, the Holy See has modified the method of distributing the ashes, as outline in the following: “After extending his hands over those present, the Priest says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general. He then cleanses his hands, puts on a face mask and distributes the ashes to those who come to him or, if appropriate, he goes to those who as standing in their places. The Priest takes the ashes and sprinkles them on the head of each one without saying anything.” (Robert Card. Sarah, *Prefect*, Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments)
