Dear Parishioners,

Last week we reviewed some characteristics of a catholic funeral. I will like to continue by explaining other essential aspects of this celebration.

Incense: Incense serves a twofold purpose in the funeral rites: to show respect for the deceased's body which became a temple of the Holy Spirit in baptism and to represent the prayers of the assembly on the deceased's behalf, rising to God's throne. **Flowers:** Flowers may be used "in moderation" (OCF, 38). Some parishes have specific rules on the use of flowers, so it is a good idea to check with parish staff before making arrangements.

Liturgical color: For funeral Masses in the United States, the sacred ministers may wear white, violet, or black vestments. "The liturgical color chosen for funerals should express Christian hope but should not be offensive to human grief or sorrow" (OCF, 39). This is the choice of the sacred minister, but if you have a preference, feel free to express it.

These are some considerations in planning a Catholic funeral taken from "Understanding and planning Catholic funerals" pamphlet that is available in the foyer of the church.

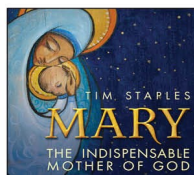

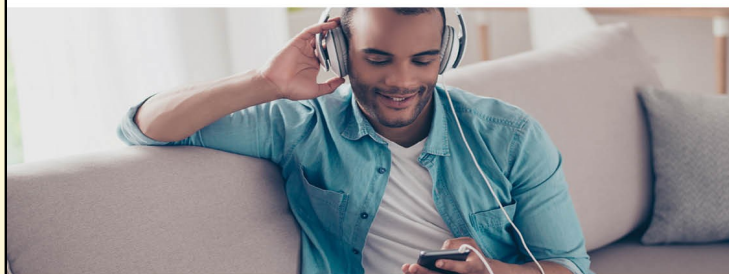
