Dear parishioners,

As you probably have heard, the coronavirus has reached Kittitas County. In the United States, as Tuesday morning, 747 people have tested positive for coronavirus and at least 26 patients with the virus have died. On the other hand, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has reported that more than 20,000 people have died of influenza during this Flu Season and between 34 to 49 million have experience flu illness. Most people with a compromised immune system are more vulnerable to get sick with influenza.

The CDC raised this question: *Are children more susceptible to the virus that causes COVID-19 compared with the general population?* The answer is no, there is no evidence. In fact, the health organizations have reported that not a single child younger than 9 has died of coronavirus in the world. That is good news. The bad news is, there are currently no antiviral drugs recommended or licensed by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for COVID-19. Usually, the flu season will last until early May in the northern hemisphere, so there is hope the coronavirus will not become a pandemic this year. Our recommendation is that we all should use common sense in protecting from viruses, frequent hand washing, refraining from touching our face, etc.

EUCCHARIST ADORATION will resume this year on St. Joseph day, Thursday, March 19, after morning Mass until 3:30PM. We are in need on adorers. There is a sign-in binder in the church foyer for any person that would like to sign is as volunteer adorer this year.

MORNING MASS ON FRIDAYS has been rescheduled to 7 AM during the Lenten season.

THE DEANERY MEETING with Bishop Tyson has been postponed and will be rescheduled later in the year due to spring break and other conflicts.

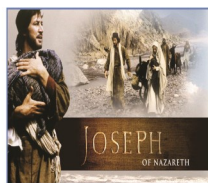
