During the month of July and August the **Sacrament of First Holy Communion** will be celebrated at Masses.

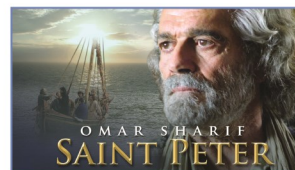
