The lessons of Christ's miracles are sometimes deceptively profound: "The child is not dead, but asleep." The Gospel looks beyond appearances to reveal that the rich are actually poor, the sighted are often blind, and death is not always the moment one stops breathing. Modern society is full of sleepwalkers, the spiritual zombies known in popular culture as "the walking dead."
