Dear Parishioners,

As you know by now, effective July 1st Cardinal Dolan appointed me as the new pastor of St. Patrick's Parish. To let you know a bit about me, I grew up in St. Elizabeth's Parish in the Washington Heights section of Manhattan. I attended the parish school and went on to graduate from Cardinal Hayes H.S. in the Bronx. I had always thought of the priesthood growing up but after graduation I was drawn to the life of a teaching Brother. After a brief time, I realized it was not for me and found employment in Con Edison. The thought of a priestly vocation always kept coming back into my mind and after 9 years at Con Edison; I entered the Seminary in Dunwoodie and was ordained in 1984. I have had 4 previous assignments: St. Brendan's, Bronx; St. Anthony, Nanuet; St. Patrick's Cathedral from 1996-2006, and then as pastor of Immaculate Heart of Mary, Scarsdale for the last 12 years. So once again I find myself in a parish dedicated to St. Patrick. I hope we will soon get to know each other and grow in faith together as a parish family. I am not too familiar with this part of Westchester but I hope to learn quickly, especially to learn where the good restaurants are! I am very happy to be here with you and I ask that you please keep me in your prayers. Please be patient with me as I get to know my way around and, most of all, to get to know each of you.
