### ***Shepherds Needed***

Sheep are animals that need an authentic and vigilant shepherd because they can't manage on their own. During the time of Jeremiah, the imagery is used critically of those leaders who fail in shepherding the people who are lost. Through Jeremiah, God promises to "raise up shepherds" who will be reliable. They were much needed also in Jesus' day, for the Gospel also describes a crowd that had no shepherd. The image seems to portray an unruly crowd that were in desperate need of teaching. Perhaps today we ought to consider the ways in which we are shepherd leaders and whether we are authentically fulfilling our baptismal call to spread the gospel message of love and service, thus bringing God's peace to a world in need.


