Partner-in-Faith Prayer

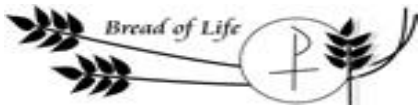

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

As we continue reading Chapter 6 of St. John's Gospel, we hear how the crowds followed Jesus because he had fed them and they wanted to be fed again. While Jesus had satisfied their physical hunger, He wanted them to know that His main purpose was to feed them spiritually. Just as Moses had fed the people of Israel in the desert with manna for their journey to the Promised Land, so now Jesus wants to feed them and us for our journey to eternal life. We hear the Lord identify Himself as the "Bread of Life" who gives life to the world.

The Second Vatican Council defined the Eucharist as "the source and summit" of our lives. It is only through the grace of this Sacrament that we receive the nourishment we need to live up to the challenges of the Gospel and remain in Christ. Only Jesus can satisfy the hunger that exists in our hearts and souls as He gives the gift of Himself to us. As we receive Jesus in Holy Communion, may it satisfy the longing for the Lord's presence in each of us.

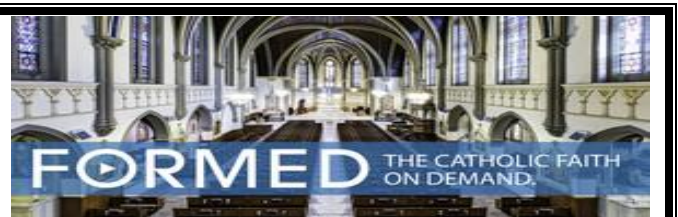
