## *FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:*

Dear Parishioners,

On this Fifth Sunday of Lent we hear the Gospel story of the woman caught in the act of adultery. The Scribes and Pharisees are quick to condemn her and are ready to carry out the sentence as mandated by the Law. They want to stone her to death. Jesus did not deny them the right to carry out this prescription of the Law, but he insisted on one condition, namely, that they first acknowledge that they have no sin on their consciences. They all drop their stones as they recognize that they too are sinners. The self-righteous observers of the Law, so eager to throw stones, could not measure up to the one requirement that Jesus had laid down. Jesus does not condemn the woman nor does He in any way condone the sin that the woman was obviously guilty of. He simply bids her to go and sin no more.

The Lord often reminds us not to be judgmental or to be so quick to condemn those whom we perceive as great sinners. We each have fallen short at times of what the Lord asks us to do and to be. We are all in need of redemption and forgiveness. Jesus always affords us the opportunity to avail ourselves of God's mercy. In these last weeks of Lent hopefully we will take that opportunity to receive the grace of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

We will have six hours of Confession on "Reconciliation Monday", April 15 from 3 PM to 9 PM. Please join us!
