## *Mother's Day*

As we did last year in celebration of Mother's Day, beginning next week, April 27<sup>th</sup> & April 28<sup>th</sup>, we will again have Mother's Day cards available at the entrances to the Church. No intentions have been taken for any of the Masses on Sunday, May 12<sup>th</sup>. Every Mass will be offered for our living or deceased Mothers whose names will be placed on the Altar. The Mass of Anticipation, Saturday evening at 5:30pm will be offered for the living and deceased members of the Parish that must be offered every weekend.

The cards have two envelopes, one for the card itself and the larger one to be filled out with the mother's name and checking off if she is alive or deceased, and then handed in before the actual date. A "free will offering" will be appreciated but is not mandatory. There will be some larger envelopes, without cards, available for those for whom no card is necessary. For example, those whose grandmothers, mothers, or Godmothers are all deceased.

Dear Parishioners,

Years ago, there was a movie made about the life of Jesus called "The Greatest Story Ever Told." His story we believe is truly great because it tells us of the infinite love of God who sent His Son into the world to accomplish His plan for our salvation. It tells of the obedience of Jesus to His Father's will and the sacrificial offering of His life for each of us.
