Dear Parishioners,

We have the opportunity to pursue two indulgences this year during the month of November 2020. Two indulgences cannot be received on the same day.

- 1) Visit a cemetery or if you cannot visit, imagine visiting. While there, pray a rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, or read and meditate on scripture.
- 2) Visit a Church, or pray at home, for All Souls. Pray an Our Father and the Creed.

The usual conditions for an indulgence apply, namely:

- A) Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father — often an Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be.
- B) Sacramental Confession 20 days before to 20 days after the day you do the work to receive the indulgence. One confession is acceptable for many indulgences during this 40 day period.
- C) Have no attachment to any sin, even venial. Should some attachment to sin be present, the indulgence will be partial, not plenary (full).
- D) Receive the Holy Eucharist, once for each Indulgence.
