As October ends next weekend we have “All Saints’ Day” and “All Souls’ Day”. In our diocese, “All Saints’ Day” is not a Holy Day of Obligation when it falls on a Monday. We will have a November 1, All Saints’ Mass at Holy Cross at the usual Monday time of 12:15 PM and at St. Luke at the normal time of 7:00 PM.

On November 2, All Souls’ Day we will have Mass at Holy Cross at 7:00 AM and 12:15 PM, and at St Luke’s at 7:00 PM. All Souls’ Day has never been “obligatory” because Catholics have always desired to participate in one or even two Masses that day!

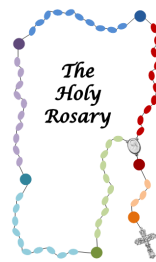

The Holy Cross facilities are available to all ACTIVE parishioners. This includes the use of the church for Baptism, Weddings & other Sacramental events. Active Membership is determined as follows:

- Registered in the parish for at least 6 months.
- Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days.
- Financial support of the church according to your means.

Marriage: The engaged couple should contact the parish office at least EIGHT months prior to the intended wedding date to schedule an appointment with the Priest.

Baptism: Parents must call the parish office to schedule a meeting with the Priest.
