Dear Parishioners,

For whatever reason, most priests take Monday off. I have been most blessed to have a weekly meeting Monday mornings with a few men who read and share thoughts and questions about the readings for the upcoming Sunday. This allows me to begin my work week in a relaxed yet productive manner, then celebrate the 12:15 Mass, then take care of any minor office work needed before a relaxing Tuesday off. Fairly often, Mondays include visits to the sick.

This plan has also a most important ramification for parishioners — especially when holidays fall on Monday! Yes, we have Mass at Holy Cross Monday, Labor Day, at 12:15. It's not unusual to find people from neighboring parishes join us!

I will modify my weekly schedule September 14 & 15 so that we will have Mass on Tuesday, September 14 — the Feast of the Holy Cross. Mass will be at Holy Cross on Tuesday, September 14 and my day off that week will be Wednesday.

If you suspect abuse has occurred within a family:

Contact the Department of Social Services within the county the abuse took place.

Contact the Diocese, to report status at 843-261-0430.

If you suspect an abuse has occurred that involved diocesan personnel (priests, deacons, teachers, employees or volunteers) contact:

The local police department immediately.
