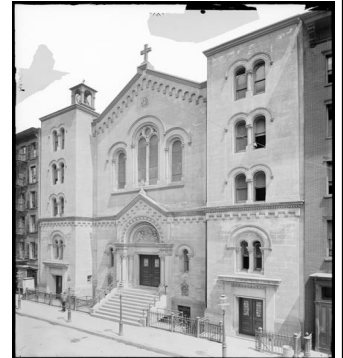

**2018 MASS BOOK:** The Mass Book for next year is officially open. We will try our best to accommodate you, but we can't always succeed. Our Mass schedule allows for Masses on Wednesdays at 12:10PM and Saturdays at 5:30PM (Vigil Mass for Sunday). There are special occasions such as an annual Mass for the many societies here at MPB, Saint Anthony Novena, San Gennaro Feast, etc. You will, of course, be notified when these Masses take place.

**MPB RECTORY:** Many of you have no doubt seen the construction of what looks like a little house in our old sacristy. This will eventually, in the near future, be the office space for the secretary and Bill Russo. This is where you will have to come for all your church business: scheduling Masses, Mass cards, etc. Anything that you come to the rectory for now will take place here. We are praying for a smooth, problem-free transition – we ask for your prayers, as well.
