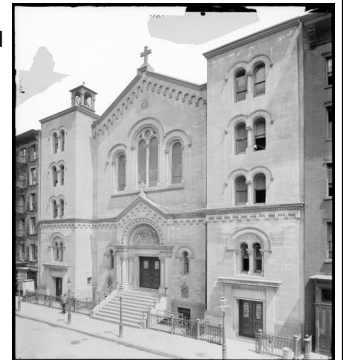

**CHURCH BEHAVIOR:** We are thrilled that some of our parishioners feel so comfortable inside the church they confuse it with being in their own living rooms; this is obvious by the volume of their conversations with fellow parishioners/friends while waiting for Mass to begin. That being said, we want to remind you that you are not in your living rooms or anywhere else in your own homes. You are in God's house. As a 'visitor' in God's house, we ask that you respect where you are and respect those around you. People come into church to pray or to speak to God for reasons which are personal and known only to them, as it should be.

While in church, there is the expectation of having a silent conversation with our Creator. People view loud conversations taking place around them to be both distracting and disrespectful. We know this because of the many complaints we have received over the past few weeks. We ask you to look within yourselves and be honest about what you discover. If you find that you are one of the people we refer to above, we have a favor to ask of you. If you must carry on a conversation inside the church, please make every effort to keep your voices low, almost to a whisper. If for some reason you cannot do this because of a hearing problem, etc., we ask that you take your conversation outside.

We hope you understand why this request was made, and we thank you for making the effort to go along with it and the requests of your fellow parishioners/visitors.

**DONATIONS:** are still being sought for both the Buongiorno Project and our Most Precious Senior Citizen's Club. Donations to the Buongiorno Project will help fund the repair/cleaning of the artwork which graces the walls and ceiling in the church, and donations to our Senior Club will help us to continue offering our senior coffee socials and, once a month, lunch. Now that we need to take them off-premises and pay a café or restaurant, we need money. Our funds have dwindled to a pitiful few dollars. The senior enjoy this time with their neighbors/friends, and we would hate to have to cancel the program because of lack of funds.
