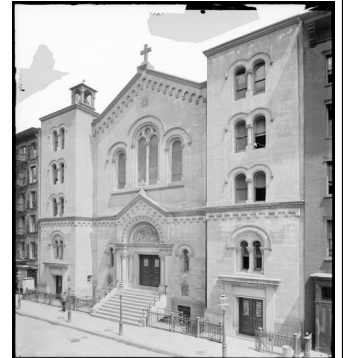
MARCH 17TH AND MARCH 19TH:
