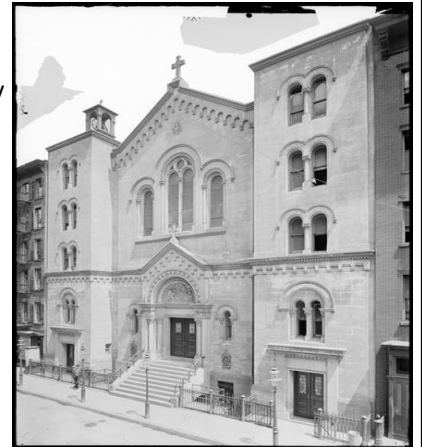

SAINT ANTHONY NOVENA:
 Tuesday, May 8, will be week 8 of our Saint Anthony Novena. The novena is prayed every Tuesday immediately after the 12:10PM Mass and will continue until Tuesday, June 12th. Saint Anthony's feast day is Wednesday, June 13th, and will be celebrated at our weekly Wednesday Mass at 12:10PM. Blessed Saint Anthony bread will be distributed on the feast day.



ASCENSION THURSDAY: There will be a Vigil Mass here at Most Precious Blood Church for Ascension Thursday. The Mass will be at 6:00PM on Wednesday, May 9th. The Vigil Mass came about because the NYS Catholic Court of Attaches Guild, a not-for-profit organization, sponsors a Mass and an annual dinner the evening before Ascension Thursday. The Guild is relatively new to us here at MPB; this is only the second or third year they are holding their event here in Little Italy. The Mass will be celebrated by Father Robert Campagna, O.F.M., the Franciscan Minister Provincial.

We no longer hold vigil Masses on a regular basis at Most Precious Blood Church, and many people may not be aware of this particular Mass if they did not read the Bulletin. Please spread the word to those people you feel would be interested in attending a Vigil Mass for Ascension Thursday.

MPB CHURCH OFFICE HAS RELOCATED and is now situated in the area that used to be the Sacristy of Most Precious Blood Church; essentially, you will see it as you enter the church using the Mulberry Street entrance while we still have access to it. Eventually everyone will have to enter both the office and the church using the Baxter Street entrance only, but it is our hope that the Mulberry Street entrance will be open to us at least for the next few months.
