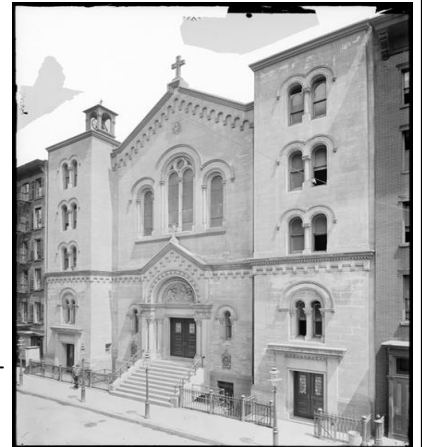

MADONNA DEL SOCCORSO DI SCIACCA: A week or so ago we mentioned the permanent addition of the Madonna del Soccorso di Sciacca to Most Precious Blood Church. The Madonna is located to the left of the Lady of Lourdes Shrine on the Baxter Street side of the church. This beautiful statue is over 100 years old and, as also previously mentioned, she has been moved around a few times in the past few years. Consequently, she was in need of repair.

Our resident master of saint renovations, Teddy Gregoris and his partner, Sera Salera, stepped up to do whatever was necessary to restore the Madonna to her full and total glory. Teddy and Sera completed the work this past Tuesday; all that remains now is for the paint to dry completely. In a day or so, her restored crown and her robes will be returned to her and she will once again stand majestically, club in hand, waiting to protect the world from the evil that surrounds and threatens us every day.

A million thanks to Teddy and Sera for donating their time and talents once again; thanks to them, the Madonna del Soccorso di Sciacca has been perfectly restored. May their kindness and generosity come back to them tenfold.
