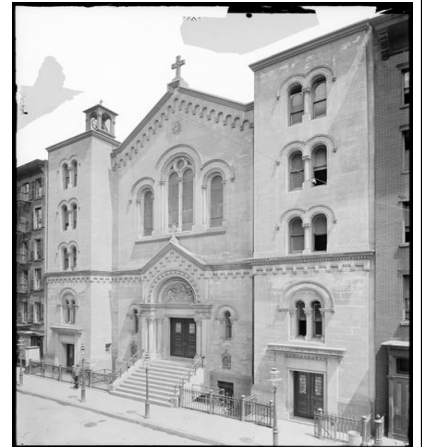

BULLETIN NEWS – AUGUST 4-5, 2018

2018 FEAST SEASON: As we enter the month of August, we also begin the season of feasts as they pertain to Most Precious Blood Church. The first of these religious celebrations comes on Sunday, August 19, 2018. The San Rocco Society will hold its annual Mass in honor of San Rocco at 12:00 Noon. Immediately following the Mass, the religious procession will begin with the carrying of their beautiful San Rocco statue. The procession will start outside the main entrance of Most Precious Blood Church on Baxter Street and will continue throughout Little Italy and Chinatown.



Of course, September is when the San Gennaro Feast is held. The feast dates for 2018 are September 13th through September 23rd. As of this writing, the annual solemn Mass honoring San Gennaro is scheduled to start at 6:00PM on his feast day, September 19th.

In October, we celebrate two saints at Most Precious Blood – San Vincenzo Martire di Craco sponsored by the Craco Society, and Sant'Angelo (Beato Angelo) di Acri. Both society Masses for their respective saints will be held on the same day, Sunday, October 28. The Mass for San Vincenzo will be at 10:30AM. The Mass for Sant'Angelo will be at 12:30PM. Additional details, if any are necessary, will follow.

SAINTS COSMA & DAMIANO: For the second year in a row, the annual Mass for Sts. Cosma & Damiano will be held at the Basilica of St. Patrick's Old Cathedral. The Mass will be on Sunday, October 7 at 12:45PM.

DONATIONS are needed for the repair of the mirror-tiled ceiling in the Saint Padre Pio Shrine area. We would like to have this work completed before the San Gennaro feast. There will be a special showing of Saint Pio relics at the Basilica of St. Patrick's Old Cathedral during the feast and, in conjunction with that week-long event, we intend to have a special Mass in honor of St. Pio on September 22nd at MPB - it would be both disrespectful and embarrassing if there is a gaping hole in the ceiling of the shrine dedicated to this beloved saint.
