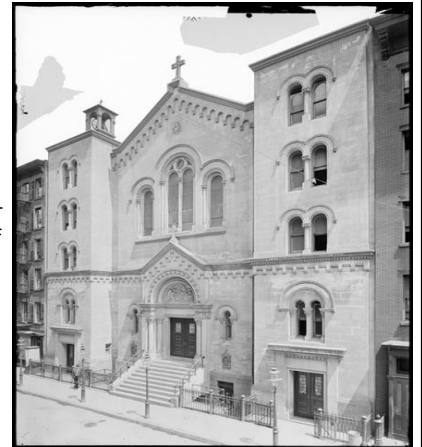

IMPORTANT NEWS REGARDING MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD CHURCH: As of Tuesday, August 7, 2018, there will **NO LONGER BE ACCESS INTO THE CHURCH OR OFFICE FROM MULBERRY STREET.** The courtyard itself will not be sealed off for a few weeks; however, a concrete wall will be built inside the current office from floor to ceiling, cutting off access into the church or office. Everyone will have to use the main entrance on **BAXTER STREET.**



This is a very sad, heartbreaking event; losing the rectory and the access it provided into the church is devastating on so many levels, especially for our senior citizens and all faithful physically-challenged people wishing or needing to visit MPB. We just have to believe that God will look out for us and grace us with whatever is necessary to insure our church does not suffer from this loss in the coming years.
