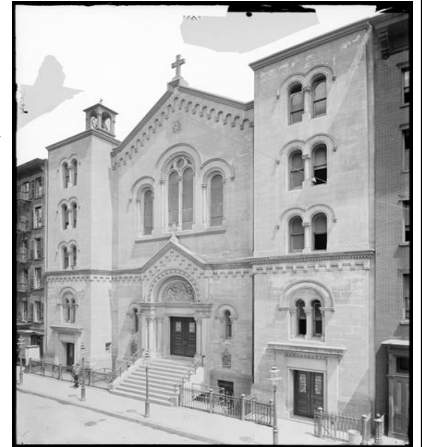
**FREE SENIOR CITIZEN'S LEGAL ASSISTANCE**
