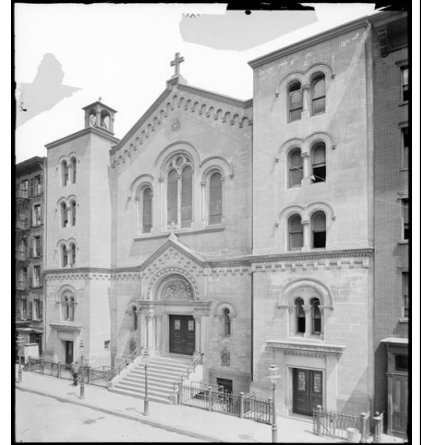

**UPCOMING SAINT FEAST DAY CELEBRATIONS/MASSSES:**

On Sunday, October 28, 2018, there will be two Masses in honor of two saints. At 10:30AM, there is a Mass in honor of San Vincenzo Martire di Craco, sponsored by the Craco Society. A short bio on San Vincenzo appeared in last week's Bulletin.

At 12:30PM, there is a Mass in honor of Sant'Angelo d'Acri, sponsored by the Beato Angelo Society. Sant'Angelo and Beato Angelo are one and the same; Angelo was canonized a saint October 15, 2017. Over 100 years ago, immigrants from the town of Acri, Italy, settled in New York City in search of a better life for themselves and their families. As most immigrants did, they brought with them a devotion to their patron saint, Beato Angelo (Blessed Angelo). Angelo's parents were poor people but rich in faith. During a sermon by Fr. Antonio da Olivadi, Angelo felt the need for a religious vocation and entered the Cappuchin Monastery. In 1691 Angelo took his solemn vows. He completed his theological studies and was ordained a priest in 1700 in the Cappuchin Order of Franciscans. His sermons were strong and impacted the people of southern Italy. His preachings resulted in many people's conversions to Catholicism. Angelo performed miracles, a gift from God. He was able to heal the sick by placing his hand on their heads. He, himself, experienced a miracle when, after becoming blind six months before his death, he regained his sight to celebrate Mass. He died in 1739 at age 70 in Acri, Italy. Angelo was beatified in 1825 and, finally, was canonized as a saint on October 15, 2017. His feast day is celebrated on the last Sunday of October.
