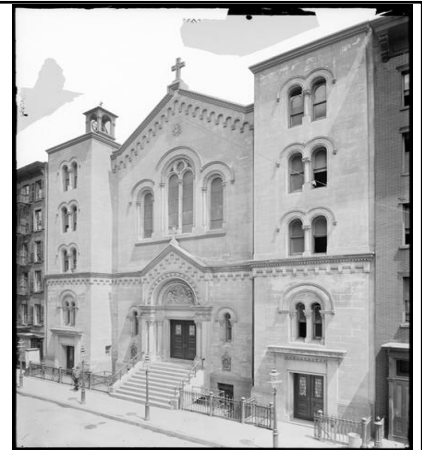

Since his retirement in 2014, Father Fabian had been residing at the Padua Friary on Thompson Street.



We pray Fr. Fabian will Rest in Peace; After ministering to our parishioners for 23 years, it is hard to remember other pastors who came before him; not only was he here longer than anyone else (to our knowledge), but he was larger than life and had a profound impact on so many who met him.

Fr. Fabian's final resting place is the Mount Alvernia Friary Cemetery in Wappingers Falls, New York.
