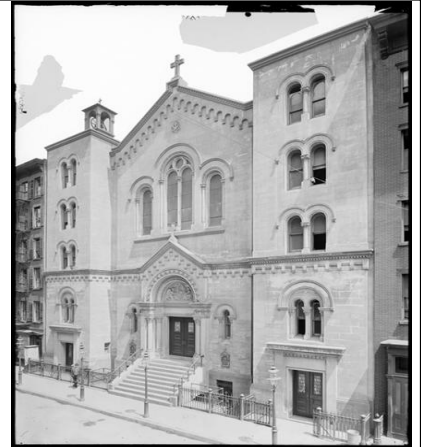

OUR LADY OF LOURDES:

The Saint Anthony novena takes place every Tuesday with the dates this year being March 19 through June 11. Our novena, of course, depends upon priest availability. If circumstances change and no one is available, we will need to cancel the novena. While we do not anticipate this happening, it wouldn't hurt to pray that everything goes according to our regular novena schedule.
