**BULLETIN NEWS –  
AUGUST 17-18, 2019**

**SUNDAY, AUGUST 18, 2019**

marks the 130th Feast of San Rocco di Potenza. St. Rocco was born of noble parentage in Montpellier, France. He was born with a red cross-shaped birthmark on his chest and showed a great devotion to God as a young child. After being orphaned by the death of his parents at an early age and being left to be raised by his uncle, The Duke of Montpellier, Rocco gave all his wealth to the poor and took a vow of poverty. He departed for Rome and stopped in many cities along the way, curing people of the plague everywhere he went. During his travels, he contracted the disease himself which caused an open sore on his leg. He was banished from the city and took refuge in a cave where the only food he had was bread, miraculously brought to him every day by a dog who wouldn't eat. Rocco was only discovered when the Lord of a nearby castle followed the dog into the woods and into the cave. The Lord took pity on Rocco and took him into his castle where Rocco was cured.



San Rocco traveled through northern Italy for two-three years before returning to his birthplace in France. The townspeople didn't recognize him because he was so weak and sick, and he was jailed as a spy despite any proof of his guilt. Five years later, San Rocco was near death with his body illuminated with a blue light when he was found by a guard. After bringing this news to the Governor who demanded to know San Rocco's identity, San Rocco's reply that he was the Governor's nephew was confirmed by the red cross-shaped birthmark on his chest. A voice from up above announced that San Rocco's soul merited immortal glory in heaven and he was taken home to God. This was on August 16, 1378 which is why San Rocco is remembered and honored every year on August 16th.
