## A Message from Father Graebe

### Welcome to the Basilica!

We're excited to welcome some new faces to Old St. Patrick's. You may have met some of them at Mass over the past few weekends. We're glad to have them here, as it allows us, your priests, to serve you even more fully in the sacraments, catechesis, pastoral care, and a wide variety of parish programs.

**Father Jason Smith, LC** is hardly a new face to many of us at Old St. Pat's, as he's been involved in a number ministries here for many years. But we're pleased to welcome him in his new role as Parochial Vicar. As he is now assigned to the Basilica full time, Fr. Jason will be a much more regular presence and will be involved in every aspect of parish life, especially preparation for the sacraments of baptism and matrimony. Fr. Jason is originally from Minnesota, and was ordained in 2006. As a seminarian he studied classical humanities at the Novitiate of the Legionaries of Christ in Cheshire CT, philosophy at Our Lady of Thornwood, in NY, and theology at Regina Apostolorum in Rome. After ordination, he dedicated six years to youth work in the NY Tri-State by running the Regnum Christi Mission Corps, a program for college-aged missionaries.

**Fr. Daniel Ray, LC** will be in residence at the Basilica, assisting us with Masses while serving as a chaplain to the Lumen Institute of the Legionaries of Christ. Fr. Daniel was born and raised outside Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. He grew up in the United Methodist Church, and converted to Catholicism in college. Following graduation he entered the Legionary Novitiate in Cheshire, Connecticut. He studied philosophy and theology in Rome, and was ordained in 2006. Following ordination, he served in Sacramento California at the University of Sacramento and the National Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe. For the next eight years he served as the President of The Highlands School, a Regnum Christi school in Las Colinas, TX.

**Mr. Paul Kucharski** is a seminarian for the Archdiocese of New York and has been assigned to Old St. Pat's. For the last eight years, Paul was an associate professor of philosophy at Manhattanville College. As he prepares to begin his theological studies, Paul will be spending the year with us and will be serving at Mass, assisting with weddings and funerals, visiting the sick and homebound, visiting religious education classes, and gaining first-hand experience in parish work and priestly life.
