TWO SOCIETY MASSES THIS

WEEKEND: Tomorrow, Sunday, October 27, 2019 there will be two Masses; the annual Mass in honor of San Vincenzo Martire di Craco will be at 10:30AM, sponsored by the Craco Society, and the annual Mass in honor of Sant’Angelo D’Acri (Beato Angelo) will be at 12:30PM, sponsored by the Beato Angelo Society. EVERYONE IS INVITED TO ATTEND EITHER ONE OR BOTH OF THESE MASSES.



San Vincenzo was a soldier in the Roman army, specifically the Theban Legion. Before battle, the soldiers in the troop were ordered by the Roman General to make a sacrifice to the Roman gods. Being Christians, they refused to honor a false god. After unsuccessful attempts to force them to make a sacrifice, the general executed the entire Legion. San Vincenzo was among those who were slaughtered and given the status of martyr for his faith. Upon bringing the devotion from Italy to America, the first celebration was held outside Most Precious Blood Church while it was still under construction. The statue in our church was made on Spring Street in 1901; it was originally in St. Joachim’s Church, then moved to St. Joseph’s Church and ultimately found its way back to Most Precious Blood in 2015.

Beato Angelo (Blessed Angelo) was born in Acri, Italy to poor parents; what they lacked in resources they made up for in faith. During a sermon by a priest, Angelo felt the need for a religious vocation and entered the Cappuchin Monastery; he took his solemn vows in 1691 and was ordained a priest in the Cappuchin Order of Franciscans in 1700. His sermons were strong and impacted the people of southern Italy. His preachings resulted in the conversion of many people to Catholicism. Angelo performed miracles, a gift given to him by God. He was able to heal the sick by placing his hand on their heads. Angelo, himself, experienced a personal miracle when, after becoming blind six months before his death, he regained his sight and was able to celebrate Mass. Angelo was beatified in 1825 and was finally canonized as a saint on October 15, 2017. FYI: Padre Pio, now St. Pio, was a Franciscan from the Capuchin Order.

ALL SAINTS DAY is this Friday, November 1, 2019; it is a holy day of obligation. Unfortunately, as we have no Masses on Fridays, you will need to attend Mass at another church to fulfill this obligation. Obviously, this is also First Friday of the month.

PLEASE NOTE: TODAY, ALL SAINTS DAY, A STATUE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA WILL VISIT OUR LADY OF VICTORY CHURCH, 60 Williams Street, New York, New York. As of this writing, the hours to view Our Lady were not available; however, this is a holy day of obligation and there are numerous Masses at this church so most likely the afternoon would be the best time to visit.
